Ameera's ambition is to join the rural guerrilla and follow her late grandfather's nationalist agenda, but locating the rebels' secret organisation proves difficult. When she hears of their search for a kahena, a woman able to syphon the power of the cosmos, she must channel an extinct ancestral practice that has already cost her her mother or lose her only chance at being recruited.

Zahir is a dirt-poor worker whose only desire is to win the personal freedom money grants the rich. When he lands in prison after a scheme gone wrong, the army gives him a choice: spend his life in a cell, or join the Military Intelligence Bureau and infiltrate the rebel group. To make it out alive, he must not only return to a country he fled as a child, but pretend he cares for it too.

Their paths cross in the rebellious mountain chain, a countryside scarred by a fight for independence which demands cruel leaders more than it does honorable heroes. As she trains to become a weapon of war, Ameera is confronted with moral choices that force her to shed the myth of noble resistance she'd forged, whilst Zahir unearths secrets tying the very rebel group he came to destroy with his own family history.

When colonial violence propels the rural guerrilla into an urban war, Ameera and Zahir get pulled to opposite sides. To win, they must question their dedication to freedom and the sacrifice it entails – the fatal choice between country, family, or their own humanity.
